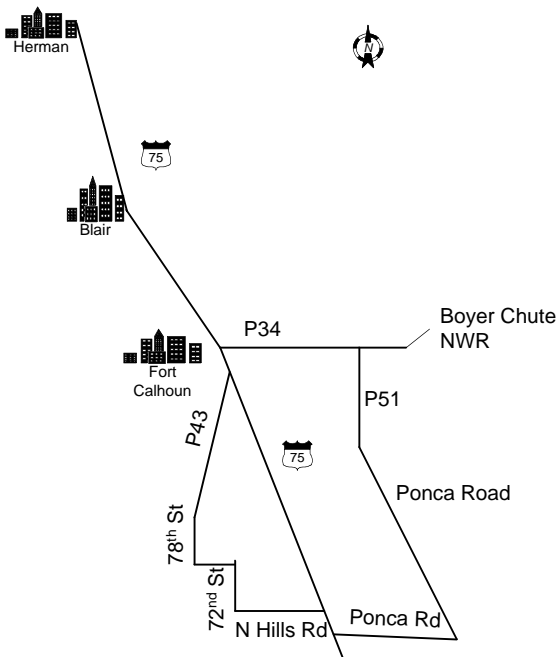

Scenic Bike to Boyer 2010 will begin at the Fort Calhoun Volunteer Fire Department in Fort Calhoun, NE. Route choices:

- Route 1 - Fort Calhoun to Boyer Chute NWR, then through Ponca Hills, and back to Fort Calhoun. 26 miles
- Route 2 - Route 1 + Roundtrip to Blair. 46 miles
- Route 3 - Route 1 + Roundtrip to Herman. 66 miles

Registration 7:00AM - 7:45AM:

Fort Calhoun Fire Department Parking Lot, 14th & Stevenson St., Fort Calhoun, NE (on Hwy 75).

Ride Starts: 8:00AM

Registrations will be accepted the day of the ride, but T-shirts are not guaranteed after July 6.

Free Family Fun Ride 8:30AM

Ride out to the Chute and return, a relaxed 8 mile loop with only one hill. Drawing for two kid's bikes at 9:30AM at the Chute for Family Fun Ride participants. All ages are welcome and registration is not required to ride; however, riders under 18 must ride with a parent or guardian.
